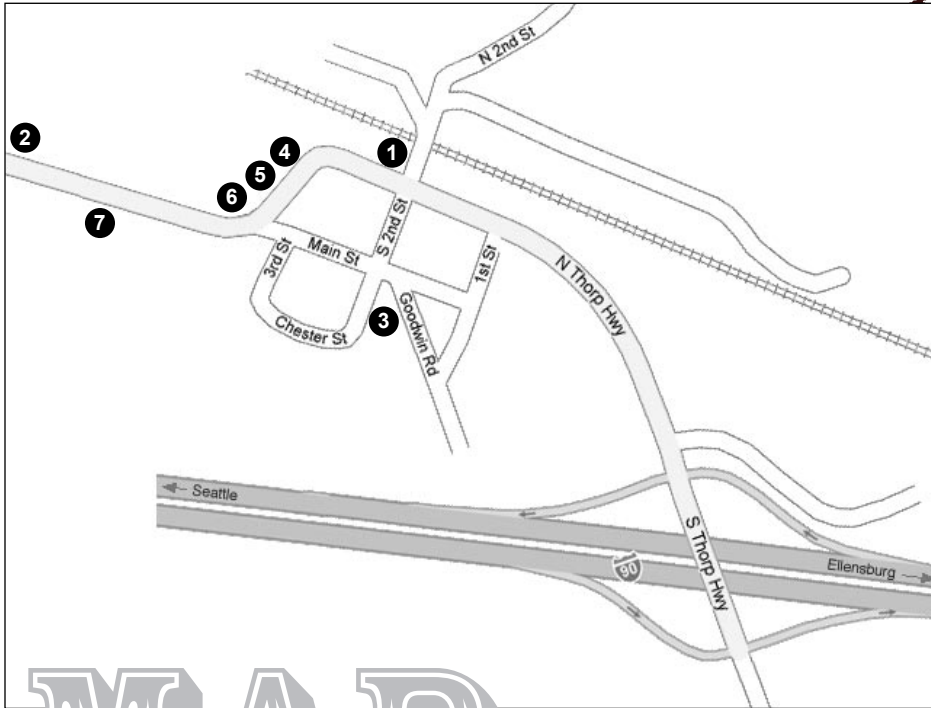


PUNCH SUMMERFEST
